- Data/operating experience available to document how successful the practice has been.

Description of Experience Using the Practice:

- Describe the operating experience with the practice, with a particular focus on the evolution of its development, end user experience, and the role the practice plays in addressing the social health determinants.

Willingness to participate in a follow-up Community Forum or Teleconference to discuss the practice in greater detail with stakeholders with a view toward sharing the practice and replication potential with other communities. An intervention that works in one community may not work in another -- success depends on many factors that are specific to individuals and communities.
